Glorifying God through Prayer

A second reason for praying is for God to be glorified in the answer. God said: ***Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me (Psalm 50:15, NKJV).***

We should daily take advantage of every opportunity that we have to glorify God because we were created to glorify God (Isaiah 43:7, 21; Revelation 4:11). We were converted to glorify God (Ephesians 1:3-14; cf. 1 Corinthians 6:20). We were chosen to glorify God (1 Peter 2:9a). We were called to glorify God (1 Peter 2:9b).
