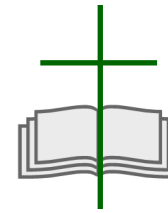

## Words to Stand On

### Some of the Ways God Speaks to Us Today

God speaks mainly through His Word – the Bible. We can turn to the Bible and get a word from God any time day or night.

Another way that God speaks to us is through songs. I recommend that you make a playlist consisting of at least one song in which God is speaking to you. Add to the list at least one song in which you are speaking to God. Also a song in which you are speaking to others, such as "It Is Well with My Soul." God also speaks to us through shepherds or pastors (John 10:27 servants (1 Samuel 2:27-36; 3:16-18; Jonah 3:1-10), strangers (Genesis 18:1-15; Hebrews 13:2) situations (Genesis 12:17-20; 31:1-2), storms (Jonah 1:1-17).

God is speaking all the time through various instruments. How much are we missing because we are not listening?

Let us look for God in all things and listening for God at all times. Let us stand on these words: "I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly" (Psalm 85:8).
