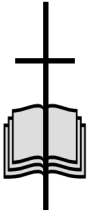

The Meaning of the Filling of the Holy Spirit

**“And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit”
(Ephesians 5:18).**

The filling of the Holy Spirit means to be under the control of the Holy Spirit. Paul gives a contrast between being under the influence of wine and being under the influence of the Holy Spirit.

There are three spirits that influence us: the human spirit, the hellish or demonic spirit, and the Holy Spirit (Luke 9:51-56; 1 Timothy 4:1). We are commanded to be under the control or influence of the Holy Spirit at all times (Ephesians 5:18).

Let us learn to discern the spirits, and let us stand on these words: “Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world” (1 John 4:1).

Parking Assist Ministry

We kindly remind you that the drop-off circle in front of the church is designated as a fire lane and, therefore, parking is not permitted in this area.

In alignment with the spirit of Romans 12:13, we are pleased to reintroduce the Parking Ministry, which aims to support those with mobility challenges who wish to attend church services.

This ministry is specifically designed to assist individuals who drive themselves to church but experience difficulty navigating the steep incline to the church entrance. It is important to note that this service is not intended to serve as an all-purpose valet, nor is it meant to be used for avoiding inclement weather. Additionally, it should not be utilized if you have someone available to drop you off at the entrance.

Eligible members will be able to drop off their keys with a volunteer, who will then park the vehicle and return it to the owner at the end of the service.

The Parking Ministry will commence on **Sunday, January 12th**. To participate, members must demonstrate a need for assistance and submit a completed insurance waiver form.
