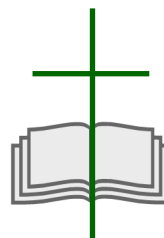

## Words to Stand On

### **Staying Filled with the Holy Spirit of God**

In Ephesians 5:18, "Be filled" translates the one Greek verb πληροῦσθε (*plērousthe*). The basic verb is πληρώω (*plēroō*, *Strong's 4137*). "Be filled" means "to be under the control of."

The Greek verb *plērousthe* is in the imperative mood, which means a command. *Plērousthe* is in the present tense, which means continuous action in the presence. *Plērousthe* is plural which means every born-again believer in Christ. *Plērousthe* is in the passive voice, which means the subject is receiving the action performed by the verb.

Let us pray daily for grace to yield to the Holy Spirit, and let us stand on these words: "*And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit*" (Ephesians 5:18, KJV).
