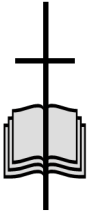

Words to Stand On

Reasons for Glorifying God, Pt. 1

One reason for glorifying God is we are commanded to give glory to God: "Give unto the LORD, O ye mighty, give unto the LORD glory and strength. Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness" (Psalm 29:1-2). "Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God" (1 Corinthians 10:31).

A second reason for glorifying God is we are created for the glory of God: "Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him. This people have I formed for myself; they shall shew forth my praise" (Isaiah 43:7, 21). According to the Westminster Shorter Catechism: "Man's primary purpose is to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever." God created everyone and everything for His glory – the Grand Canyon, mountains, valleys, lakes, rivers, seas, oceans, and so on were created for God's glory: "Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created" (Revelation 4:11).

God does what brings Him the most glory: God permitted Adam to fall because there was more glory in a pickup than in a prevention. God permitted Shadrach, Meshack, and Abednego to be put into the fiery furnace because there was more glory in a preservation than in a prevention. God allowed Daniel to be put into the lion's den because there was more glory in a preservation than in a prevention (Daniel 3:19-39; 6:18-28). Jesus permitted Lazarus to die because there was more glory in a resurrection or resuscitation than in a healing (John 11:4, 40).

Let us take advantage of every opportunity to glorify God and let us stand on these words: Christ is the one through whom God created everything in heaven and earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see – kings, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities. Everything has been created through him and for him" (Colossians 1:16, New Living Translation).
