

Words to Stand On

The Use of *Rhēma* Words

Rhēma words are specific words that fit the occasion. Jehoshaphat prayed *rhēma* words when he discovered that three nations were coming against him (2 Chronicles 20:5-12). Jesus recited *rhēma* words when He was tempted by the devil in the wilderness (Matthew 4:1-10).

Some *rhēma* words for worry or anxiety are “*Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things*” (Philippians 4:6-8, NKJV). When you are tempted to take revenge for an insult or injury, the *rhēma* words for that temptation are “*The eyes of the LORD are in every place, keeping watch on the evil and the good*” (Proverbs 15:3, NKJV). “*Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, “Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,” says the Lord*” (Romans 12:19, NKJV). When events occur in your life which you do not understand, your *rhēma* words are “*And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose*” (Romans 8:28, NKJV).

Let us memorize Scriptures that can be used as *rhēma* words, and let us stand on these words: “*This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success*” (Joshua 1:8, NKJV). “*Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You*” (Psalm 119:11, NKJV).
