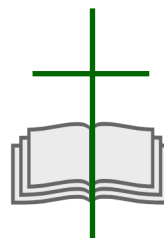

Words to Stand On

How to Guard the Glory of God

One way of guarding the glory of God is to aim to glorify God at all times and in all things (Psalm 115:1; 1 Corinthians 10:31).

A second way of guarding the glory of God is to not give others glory that belongs to God. The Bible commands us to render under honor or to whom honor is due (Romans 13:7; Ephesians 6:1-3; 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13; 1 Timothy 5:17; cf. 1 Samuel 2:30). However, we do not give to others honor that belongs to God.

A third way of guarding the glory of God is to not receive glory that belongs to God. Examples of men who refuse to receive glory that belonged to God: (1) Joseph (Genesis 41:16); (2) Daniel (Daniel 2:1-49; 5:1-30); (3) Paul and Barnabas (Acts 14:1-20).

Let us not give nor receive glory that belongs to God (Isaiah 42:8), and let us stand on these words: *Give unto the LORD, O you mighty ones, Give unto the LORD glory and strength. Give unto the LORD the glory due to His name; Worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness* (Psalm 29:1-2, NKJV).
