FATHER'S BLESSING

- 1. May the Lord continue to bless you and make you a blessing to others (Genesis 12:1-2).
- 2. May God give you grace to daily feed your faith by spending time in prayer, praise, and the Word of God (Psalm 113:1-3; Job 23:12; Matthew 4:4; Romans 10:17; 1 Thessalonians 5:17-18).
- 3. May God give you the grace to allow His Word to be your cleanser (Psalm 119:9), your constrainer (Psalm 119:11), your counselor (Psalm 119:24, 97-100), and your comforter (Psalm 119:50, 52).
- 4. God saw you before you were born, and He scheduled each day of your life before you began to breath (Psalm 139:16, Living Bible). May God bless you with the grace to daily walk in the steps He has ordered for you (Psalm 37:23; 119:133).
- 5. God has created you for His glory. May God reveal to you the means by which He has ordained for you to bring Him glory (Isaiah 43:7; 1 Corinthians 10:31).
- 6. May the Lord bless you with grace to daily pray for wisdom from above (James 1:5; cf. Psalm 119:97-100).
- 7. May the Lord bless you with good health, and may He give you the grace to be a good steward of your body (1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 3 John 2).
