Abraham Believed God

According to Joshua 24:2, Abraham was an idol worshiper when God first found him. Abraham was not a man of great faith when God called him. Abraham doubted God’s power to protect him from Pharaoh and Abimelech (Genesis 12:11-20; 20:1-18). Ishmael resulted from Abraham’s doubt that God would bless him with a son through his wife Sarah (Genesis 16:1-16). Abraham’s faith grew as he increased his obedience to God. Hebrews 11 gives a list of those whose faith grew: Abraham, Moses, Jacob, Gideon, etc.

The disciples of Jesus prayed for Jesus to increase their faith (Luke 17:5). The Bible teaches that faith in God can grow and that the Word of God is a source for the growth of faith in God: *Neither have I gone back from the commandment of his lips; I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary food* (Job 23:12, KJV). *So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God* (Romans 10:17, KJV). *As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby* (1 Peter 2:2, KJV). *But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen* (2 Peter 3:18, KJV).

Let us pray for God to give us grace to increase our meditation on the Word of God, our memorization of the Word of God, and our application of the Word of God: *This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success* (Joshua 1:8, NKJV).

Let us stand on these words: *He [Abraham] staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform* (Romans 4:20–21, KJV).
