Words to Stand On

God's Sovereignty over the Weather

The Bible teaches that God is sovereign over the weather at all times and in all places: God was sovereign over the flood (Genesis 6; 7; 8). God was sovereign over the weather in Egypt (Exodus 9; 10; 14). The sovereignty of God over the weather is described in Job 36; 37; 38. God was sovereign over the weather in Amos 4:7-8.

When God warns, judges, or disciplines a nation according to Amos 4:6-11, expect: (1) Famines (Amos 4:6), (2) Changes in the weather (Amos 4:7-8), (3) Damage to the food supply (Amos 4:9), (4), Diseases (Amos 4:10a), (5) Wars (Amos 4:10b), (6) Destruction of villages, cities by tornadoes, earthquakes, volcanoes, fires, floods, tsunamis (Amos 4:11). Expect to hear people say: "We have had this before, but never like this!" The problems that occurred in Amos 4:6-11 would have stopped if God's people had recognized their sins, repented of their sins, and returned to God. Let us practice 2 Chronicles 7:14, *"If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."*

Let us stand on these words: *"Whatever the LORD pleases He does, In heaven and in earth, In the seas and in all deep places"* (Psalm 135:6, NKJV).
