The Power of the Word of God, #6 Selected Scriptures, Minister's Class, Thursday, June 29, 2023

Introduction: Tonight I want to talk to you about the power of the Word of God. The Word of God is the source of food for spiritual nourishment (Matthew 4:4; cf. 1 Peter 2:2; Psalm 19:10; 119:103). The Word of God is a source of faith (Romans 10:17; cf. Job 23:12). I believe that the Word of God is sufficient for the servant of God to accomplish the will and work of God (2 Timothy 3:16-17; Joshua 1:8; Psalm 1:1-3).

The assignment that I gave at our last meeting was to read Psalm 119 and observe what the Bible says about itself.

- II. The Word of God Changes (John 17:17).
- III. The Word of God Corrects (2 Timothy 3:16-17).
- IV. The Word of God Cleanses (Psalm 119:9; John 15:3; Ephesians 5:25-26).
- V. The Word of God Cuts (Ephesians 6:17; Hebrews 4:12).
- VI. The Word of God Cracks (Jeremiah 23:29).
- VII. The Word of God Cautions (Psalm 19:11).
- VIII. The Word of God Constrains (Psalm 119:11; 101; cf. Psalm 139:7-12; Proverbs 15:3; Jeremiah 23:24; Hebrews 4:13; Galatians 6:7).
 - IX. The Word of God Cures (Psalm 107:17-20).
 - X. The Word of God Counsels (Psalm 119:24, 97-100).
 - XI. The Word of God Comforts (Psalm 119:50, 52; cf. Psalm 23:1-6; 27:1-14; 30:5; 34:19; 46:1-3; 61:1-3; 84:11; Isaiah 43:1-2; Hebrews 13:5; Romans 8:28, 31, 38-39; Job 19:25-27).
- XII. The Word of God Continues (Psalm 119:89; Isaiah 40:8; Matthew 24:35).
 - A. Down through the ages many have sought to destroy the Word of God.
 - B. The French philosopher Voltaire said on one occasion that in 100 years the Word of God would be extinct. 100 years after Voltaire made that statement he was dead, and his home was purchased by the Geneva Bible Society and was used to print Bibles...
