



Glorifying God through Prayer and Praise

Three things we cannot do too much of: (1) We cannot pray too much (1 Thessalonians 5:17). (2) We cannot ponder the Word of God too much (Joshua 1:8; Psalm 1:1-3). (3) We cannot praise God too much (Psalm 113:3).
