## Words to Stand On

### Paul Believed God

Paul had peace in a storm because he believed the promises of God (**Acts 27:20-25**). When a poisonous creature latched on to Paul's hand as Paul was placing sticks on a fire, Paul did not fear death because he believed the promise of God: "You must be brought before Caesar" (**Acts 27:24; 28:1-6**).

The Bible teaches that when the servant of God is in the will of God and obeying the Word of God, he or she cannot die until his or her work is done here on earth. The fire cannot burn him or her up – Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego (**Daniel 3**); the lions cannot eat him or her up – Daniel (**Daniel 6**); the sword cannot cut him or her up – Peter (**Acts 12**). When Paul's work was done here on earth, he wrote these words to Timothy: *For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing* (**2 Timothy 4:6-8, NKJV**).

Let us remember that God keeps His promises, and let us stand on these words: *Then the LORD said to me, "You have seen well, for I am watching over My word to perform it"* (**Jeremiah 1:12, NASB**).

### **Paul Believed God**

There is a difference between believing in God and believing God. There is a relationship between belief and behavior. We can determine what we believe and what others believe by observing behavior. Many of those who believe in God do not believe God. There are many times that we are depressed and discouraged because we do not believe God's Word, for example: *For promotion cometh neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south. But God is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another (Psalm 75:6-7, KJV).* *This decision is by the decree of the watchers, And the sentence by the word of the holy ones, In order that the living may know That the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, Gives it to whomever He will, And sets over it the lowest of men (Daniel 4:17, NKJV).*

*All the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of heaven And among the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain His hand Or say to Him, What have You done? (Daniel 4:35, NKJV).* *The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, Like the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes (Proverbs 21:1, NKJV).* *And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose (Romans 8:28, NKJV).* *Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things (Philippians 4:6-8, NKJV).*
