## Words to Stand On

### Prayer in Relation to Intimacy with God

A consistent prayer life is necessary to grow in intimacy with God. Jesus was both man and God, and as man, Jesus found it necessary to pray (Mark 1:34-35; Luke 6:12; 11:1). Abraham's consistent prayer life contributed to his intimacy with God. The Bible tells us that Abraham built altars on his journey to call upon God in prayer (Genesis 12:8; 13:1-4, 18). Some of the other men whose consistent prayer life contributed to their intimacy with God: Moses (Exodus 24:15-18; 33:1-23), David (Psalm 5:1-8; 55:17; 63:1-8), and Daniel (Daniel 6:10).

If you do not have a consistent prayer life, pray for God to give you the grace to develop and maintain a life of prayer (Luke 11:1).

Let us pray that God will give us the grace to grow in intimacy with Him, and let us stand on these words: "*Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded*" (James 4:8, NKJV).
