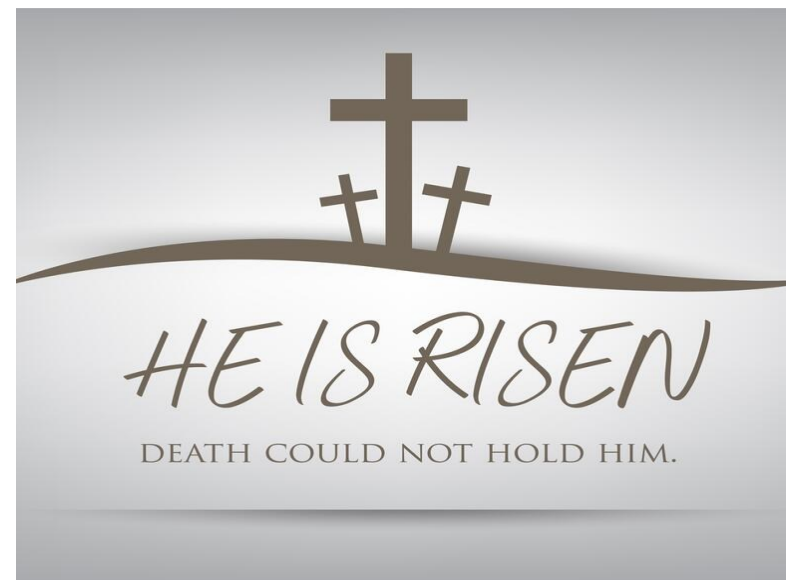

Words to Stand On

Evidence for the Resurrection of Jesus Christ

One of the pieces of evidence for the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the empty tomb. Many explanations have been given for the empty tomb, but it takes more faith to believe the different explanations than to believe the biblical accounts in Matthew 28; Mark 16; Luke 24; and John 20.

Another evidence for the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the transformation of the lives of the Apostles of Jesus. The Apostles of Jesus were transformed from cowards to courageous followers of Jesus Christ; they were transformed from fearful to faithful followers of Jesus Christ. The Apostle John was banished to the Island of Patmos where he wrote the book of Revelation. The other Apostles gave their lives for Jesus Christ. The Apostles of Jesus could not be silenced (Acts 4:1-31; 5:12-42).

Another evidence for the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the transformation of lives today all over the world. Jesus is alive in the lives of many today. Is Jesus alive in your life? You can receive Jesus at this moment if He is not in your life. Simply asked Jesus to give you the grace to repent (Acts 2:37-38; 5:31; 11:18; 2 Timothy 2:25). Ask Jesus to give you the grace to believe (Ephesians 2:8-9). Ask Jesus to give you the grace to receive Him as your Lord and Savior (John 1:12). Now, find a local church where you can be baptized, and where you can grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15-16; 1 Peter 2:2; 2 Peter 3:18).

Let us remember that Jesus is alive, and let us stand on these words: *“But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep”* (1 Corinthians 15:20, NKJV).

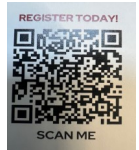
