## Words to Stand On

### **Praising God with a Song or a Hymn to God**

Another Hebrew word that is translated "praise" is "tehillah" which means "a song or hymn of praise to God" such as "How Great Thou Art." According to Psalm 22:3, "God inhabits the praises of His people." David said, "I will bless the LORD at all times His praise [tehillah] shall continually be in my mouth" (Psalm 34:1). According to Psalm 100:4, "Enter His gates with thanksgiving and into his courts with praise" [tehillah].

There is power in the "tehillah" – the song or hymn of praise to God. When Jehoshaphat had three nations coming against him, he placed the choir in front of the army. The choir led the people in praise. The first Hebrew word that is translated "praise" is "Halal" which means excitement about God (2 Chronicles 20:21a). The second Hebrew word that is translated "praise" is "yadah" which means to extend the hands in worship to God (2 Chronicles 20:21b). God intervened when the choir led the people in the third Hebrew word that is translated "praise" which is "tehillah" (2 Chronicles 20:22-24).

The Greek equivalent to the Hebrew "tehillah" is the Greek verb ὑμνεῖω (*humneō*). *Humneō* is the verb that is translated "praises" in Acts 16:25 where there was a jailhouse rock at midnight.

**Let us remember that there is power in praise, and let us stand on these words:** "I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth" (Psalm 34:1). "O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth" (Psalm 96:1).
