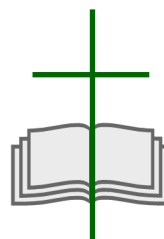

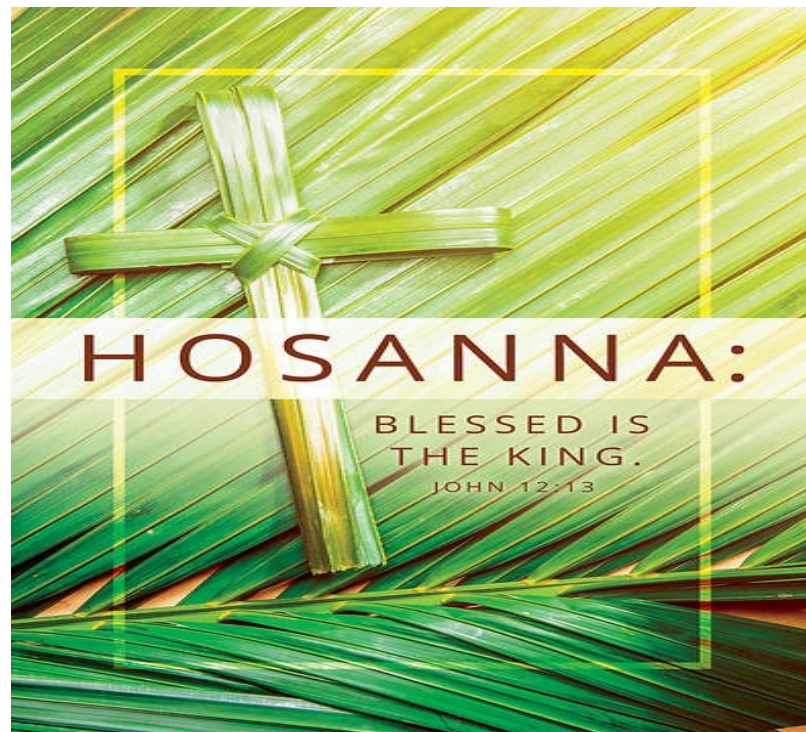

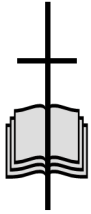

Words to Stand On

The Necessity for the Sufferings and Death of Jesus

The Bible teaches that the sufferings and death of Jesus were necessary because they were substitutionary (Isaiah 53:5-6; Matthew 20:28; Mark 8:31; Luke 24:26; John 10:17-18; Romans 3:25; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Galatians 2:20).

The justice of God requires death for sins (Ezekiel 18:4, 20; Romans 6:23). **Jesus satisfied the justice of God when He suffered and died on the cross for us:** *But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all (Isaiah 53:5-6, NKJV).* *For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Corinthians 5:21, NKJV).* *I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep (John 10:11, NKJV).* *Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father (John 10:17-18, NKJV).*

We have found redemption and forgiveness because of the substitutionary death of Jesus Christ on the cross for us: *In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace (Ephesians 1:7, NKJV).*

Let us always remember the voluntary and substitutionary sufferings and death of Jesus for us, and let us stand on these words: *For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Corinthians 5:21, NKJV).*
