

**Assignments in Relation to the Coronavirus, #3  
Coronavirus in Relation to God's Word, Parts 1 & 2**

- I. God Warns before He Judges.**
    - A. God gave 120 years of warnings through Noah before the flood (Genesis 6).**
    - B. Through the prophets Amos, Hosea, and others, God gave over 80 years of warnings to the Northern Kingdom – referred to in the Bible as Ephraim and Israel.**
      - 1. The Northern Kingdom consisted of ten tribes – later referred to as the “Ten Lost Tribes.”**
      - 2. The capital of the Northern Kingdom was Samaria.**
      - 3. The final judgment on the Northern Kingdom was the Assyrian captivity (Amos 4:12-13; cf. Isaiah 10).**
    - C. Through the prophet Jeremiah, God gave 40 years of warnings to the Southern Kingdom – referred to in the Bible as Judah.**
      - 1. The Southern Kingdom consisted of two tribes: Judah and Benjamin.**
      - 2. The capital of the Southern Kingdom was Jerusalem.**
      - 3. The final judgment on the Southern Kingdom was the Babylonian Captivity (Jeremiah; Daniel 1:1-2).**
    - D. Read the following passages, and observe the reason for God's long-suffering or patience with people: Romans 2:4; 2 Peter 3:9.**
  - II. Read the Following Passages and Observe That the Nations with the Most Light or Knowledge of God Will Be Disciplined and Judged More Severely Than Other Nations: Amos 3:2; Matthew 11:20-24; Luke 12:47-48.**
  - III. Read Matthew and John.**
    - A. Observe Matthew's references to the Old Testament Scriptures. Matthew was writing mainly to Jewish readers, and he wanted to prove that Jesus was the promised Messiah.**
    - B. What were some of the things Jesus expected because He knew the Old Testament Scriptures?**
    - C. What were some of the things that Jesus did to fulfill the Old Testament Scriptures? Or what were some of the things that Jesus did because the Bible said He would?**
    - D. Observe these words: “That it might be fulfilled”; “Then was fulfilled”; “That the Scripture might be fulfilled.”**
    - E. Observe how Jesus answered questions with questions and with the Old Testament Scriptures.**
  - IV. Read Ephesians Chapters 4, 5, and 6 – How Many of the Commandments Mentioned Are You Obeying?**
