Words to Stand On

The Command to Pray

One of the main reasons for praying is because we are commanded to pray. The following Scriptures are commands to pray: *Pray without ceasing* (1 Thessalonians 5:17, NKJV). *Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints* (Ephesians 6:18, NKJV). *Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus* (Philippians 4:6–7, NKJV).

A simple definition of sin is failing to do what God said to do and doing what God said not to do. Samuel considered it a sin to fail to pray for others. Samuel said: *Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the LORD in ceasing to pray for you; but I will teach you the good and the right way* (1 Samuel 12:23, NKJV).

Let us daily obey the command to pray for others and for ourselves, and let us stand on these words: *Pray without ceasing* (1 Thessalonians 5:17, NKJV).
