# ORDER OF SERVICE

## Words to Stand On

### Marah's and Elim's on Life's Journey Part 2

In addition to disclosing us to ourselves, God may permit or produce Marah's on life's journey to disclose Himself to us. Consider the things Moses and the children of Israel learned about God at Marah. Consider also the things that we learn about God: First, God may lead His people to Marah's even when they are in the will of God and are obeying the Word of God (Exodus 15:22-23; cf. Exodus 13:21-22; Numbers 9:15-23; Deuteronomy 1:33). Second, prayer is a means to many of the ends God has ordained. It was God's will to heal the bitter waters at Marah, but God did not heal the waters until after Moses prayed (Exodus 15:23-25). Third, Moses and the Children of Israel learned that God is "Jehovah Rapha" - the God who heals (Exodus 15:26). We also learn that God may use means to heal: God used a tree as a means to heal the bitter waters at Marah (Exodus 15:25). God used a lump of figs to heal King Hezekiah (2 Kings 20:1-7). God used salt to heal the waters at Jericho (2 Kings 2:19-22).

After healing the bitter waters at Marah, God led His people to a place called "Elim," which was like an oasis in the desert (Exodus 15:27). To enjoy your journey, it is necessary to recognize and remember that when God is leading us, there will be both "Marah's" and Elim's on life's journey. When you are at Marah, remember that there is an Elim ahead. When you are at Elim, enjoy it because God will not leave you there.

Let us stand on these words: *For His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for life; Weeping may endure for a night, But joy comes in the morning* (Psalm 30:5, NKJV).
