



Words to Stand On

Glorifying God by Declaration and Demonstration of His Attributes

One of the ways that we can glorify God is by declaring one or more of His divine attributes. The attributes of God that we cannot imitate are referred to as non-communicable. These are the attributes that we declare. Some of the non-communicable attributes that we can declare are the omnipotence of God (Psalm 19:1-3; Jeremiah 32:17); the omniscience of God (Psalm 139:1-4); the omnipresence of God (Psalm 139:7-12; Jeremiah 23:24; Hebrews 4:13), and the immutability of God (Malachi 3:6; James 1:17).

The communicable attributes of God are those attributes of God that we can imitate, such as love (John 3:16; 15:13; Romans 5:8; Galatians 5:22), grace (Ephesians 4:29, 32; Colossians 4:6), mercy (Matthew 5:7; Luke 10:25-37), long-suffering or patience with people (Exodus 34:6; Galatians 5:22), and goodness (Psalm 100:5; 136:1; Galatians 5:22).

Let us pray for grace to glorify God by declaring and demonstrating His attributes, and let us stand on these words: *“Sing to the LORD, bless His name; Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day. Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples”* (Psalm 96:2-3, NKJV).
