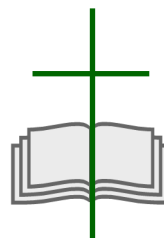

Words to Stand On

The Differences between the Filling of the Holy Spirit and the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit

The filling of the Holy Spirit means that the Holy Spirit has us – we are under His control (Ephesians 5:18). The indwelling of the Holy Spirit means that we have all of Him. The Bible teaches that all born-again believers are indwelt by all three members of the Trinity: God the Father (Ephesians 4:6); God the Son (Galatians 2:20; Colossians 1:27); and God the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:19-20). Those who are saved do not need to get more of the Holy Spirit, but the Holy Spirit needs to get more of them. Born-again believers have all of the Holy Spirit (cf. John 14:17; Romans 8:9; 2 Timothy 1:14; 1 Thessalonians 4:8; 1 John 3:24; 4:4, 13).

Remember that the same Holy Spirit that moved on the face of the water before God said "Let there be light..." indwells every believer (Genesis 1:1-3). Every born-again believer is indwelt by the same Holy Spirit that came upon Samson at Timnath and with his bare hands he slew a young lion (Judges 14:5-6). The same Holy Spirit that came upon Samson at Lehi and he slew a thousands Philistines (Judges 15:14-15). The same Holy Spirit that moved in the valley of the dry bones (Ezekiel 37). The same Holy Spirit that raised up Jesus from the dead after three days in the grave (Romans 8:11). Because we are indwelt and empowered by the Holy Spirit of God, we can face whatever we encounter on life's journey (1 John 4:4).

One of the requirements for staying filled with the Holy Spirit is obedience to God. Let us pray for grace to trust and obey God at all times and in all things, and let us stand on these words: *"Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths"* (Proverbs 3:5-6, NKJV). *"But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His"* (Romans 8:9, NKJV).
