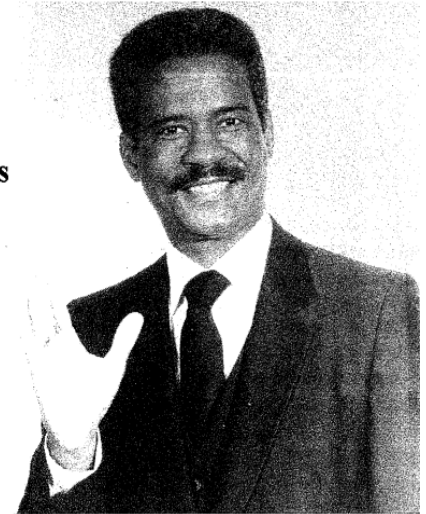
Q&A.

**Examining your questions
from God's point of view**

By Pastor Malone

*Q. What does it mean to seek God's face,
and how do I determine my hearts desire
and what I should seek in my life?*

A. Seeking God's face means getting in His face. It means getting so close to God that you can *feel the breath of the Holy Spirit blowing on you*. One way of determining the one supreme desire of your heart is to sit down and analyze what it is you're seeking after. In Psalm 27:4, David says, *"One thing have I desired of the Lord, and that will I seek after: 1) "that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life to behold the beauty of the Lord, and 2) to meditate in His temple.* David is talking here about the manifest presence of God, and as David, we too will seek after the one thing we desire. ■
