Biblical Reasons for Praying, Pt. 1

One biblical reason for praying is the Bible commands us to pray: *Pray without ceasing* (1 Thessalonians 5:17, NKJV). In Philippians 4:6-7, NKJV, we are commanded to make prayer a substitute or replacement for anxiety. Because we are commanded to pray, failing to pray is disobedience, and disobedience to God's Word is sin (1 Samuel 12:23; 1 Thessalonians 5:17). Some of the things for which we are commanded to pray: leaders (1 Timothy 2:1-7), lost souls (1 Timothy 2:4-7; cf. Romans 10:1-4; 2 Corinthians 4:3-4), laborers (Matthew 9:38). We are commanded to pray for our enemies (Matthew 5:44). We are commanded to pray for one another (Ephesians 6:18; James 5:16). We are commanded to pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Psalm 122:6).

A second biblical reason for praying is that prayer is necessary for growth in an intimate relationship with the Triune God. All of those in the Bible who had an intimate relationship with God had a consistent prayer life: Abraham (Genesis 12:8; 13:3-4, 18), Moses (Exodus 24:15-18; 33:8-23; Deuteronomy 34:10), Peter (Acts 3:1), Paul (Ephesians 1:15-18; Philippians 1:3-11; Colossians 1:3-14; 1 Thessalonians 1:2-3).

A third biblical reason for praying is so that God may be glorified in the answer: *Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me* (Psalm 50:15, NKJV).

Let us seek God's glory at all times and in all things, and let us stand on these words: *Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God* (1 Corinthians 10:31, NKJV).
