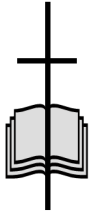

Three Continuing Activities

Prayer is to be a continuing activity for every believer because we are commanded to pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:17). Prayer is to be in the name of Jesus (John 14:13-14). Prayer is to be through Jesus. We have access to God the Father through Jesus (John 14:6; Ephesians 2:18). Prayer to God the Father is to be guided by and in the energy of the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:26-27; Ephesians 6:18; Jude 1:20).

Pondering or meditating on the Word of God is to be another continuing activity of all believers. In Joshua 1:8 and in Psalm 1:1-3, there is a reference to meditating day and night. The Hebrew verb that is translated "meditate" is "hagah" which means "to think about," "to imagine," "to speak in an undertone" or "talk to yourself." Everyone meditates every day. No one needs to learn how to meditate. We need to learn how to meditate on the right things (Philippians 4:8).

Praising God is another activity that is to be continuous by all believers. Praise is one of the ways in which we glorify God. God said: "Whoever offers praise glorifies Me" (Psalm 50:23, NKJV). David said, "I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth" (Psalm 34:1).

Let us practice praising God daily, and let us stand on these words: "Pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:17). "This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shall have good success" (Joshua 1:8). "From the rising of the sun onto the going down of the same the LORD'S name is to be praised" (Psalm 113:3).
