Words to Stand On

Paul's Prayers for the Church at Philippi Pt. 2

Paul prayed for an increase in knowledge of the Triune God of the Bible (Philippians 1:9b; cf. Ephesians 1:16-18; Colossians 1:9-10). Many problems result from a lack of knowledge and incorrect knowledge of the Triune God of the Bible. God said in Hosea 4:6, KJV: "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge." Jesus said to the Sadducees, "Ye do err, not knowing the Scripture, nor the power of God" (Matthew 22:29, KJV). The Bible commands us to grow in knowledge: "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Peter 3:18, KJV). One of God's purposes for His church is education regarding God's Word, will, and ways (Ephesians 4:11-16; cf. Acts 2:42).

Paul prayed for the Philippians to grow in discernment (Philippians 1:9c). There are three spirits that influence us: the human spirit (Luke 9:51-56), the demonic spirit (Matthew 16:21-23), and the Holy Spirit (Acts 4:8, 31; 13:9). Knowledge of the Word of God is necessary to discern the different spirits that influence us (1 Thessalonians 5:19-21; 1 Timothy 4:1; 1 John 4:1). In Philippians 1:10, the conjunction "that" points to the reasons for Paul's prayer for an increase in knowledge and in discernment. Paul wanted the Philippians to approve of the things that are excellent and not to approve of the things that are an abomination to God. Many today are approving of things that are an abomination to God because of a lack of knowledge of the Triune God of the Bible and a lack of discernment.

Let us pray for growth in knowledge and in discernment, and let us stand on these words: "*Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world*" (1 John 4:1, NKJV).
