Words to Stand On

Three Things of Which Love Is Evidence

The kind of love that the Bible commanded us to have for God and for others is *agapē* (ἀγάπη), which is supernatural, sacrificial, and superior to all other loves (John 3:16; 13:34-35; 15:13; Romans 5:5, 8; 1 Corinthians 13:1-3, 13; Galatians 5:22; 1 John 3:14; 4:7, 12, 13).

Agapē is evidence that one is a disciple of Jesus Christ. Jesus said, "A new commandment I give unto you, that ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another" (John 13:34-35).

Agapē is evidence that one is saved. John said, "We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death" (1 John 3:14).

Agapē is evidence that one is filled with the Holy Spirit of God. The filling of the Holy Spirit produces the fruit of the Holy Spirit, and the first on the list of fruits produced by the Holy Spirit is love. Paul said, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith" (Galatians 5:22).

Let us pray that God will give us the grace to love Him and to love one another, and let us stand on these words: "He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him" (John 14:21).
